Ambulatory Surgery Center

When Midlands Orthopaedics, P.A. decided to build a state of the art ambulatory surgery center, they demanded a design team with extensive experience, a thorough understanding of the functional demands of their practice, and the creativity to bring an inspiring new design statement to their campus near downtown Columbia.

The user-friendly design of the surgery center results from close collaboration between the Hunter Group Architects and the ASC staff. The curved glass facade provides a view into the dynamic, vaulted waiting room space. The main entrance is also accented by a curved canopy that provides weather protection at the patient entrance. The central nurses station serves both Pre-Op and Post-Op spaces in a particularly efficient building plan. Those spaces are brightened with outside light from clerestory windows. The efficient patient flow is the key to the compact plan of the building.

The Operating Rooms incorporate the latest in digital technology, including power equipment and anesthesia boom arms, and computerized document stations in each room.
