The design of the new assisted living center in Durham, North Carolina makes use of traditional architectural design elements. Interiors are a bright blend of contemporary materials blended with refined details.

To expand its network of senior living centers, CareMatrix chose distinctive locations in the fast-growing suburb of Roswell near Atlanta, and Pineville in Charlotte, and rapidly emerging Durham in the Research Triangle area of eastern North Carolina.

All opened in the Spring of 1999, these centers are designed to add the elements of hospitality and gracious amenities to the demanding setting of a healthcare environment for seniors. Lush landscaping and outdoor courtyards provide more recreational opportunities for the residents' activities.

Generous spaces for community activities, library, wellness center, barber and beauty shop, and gift and snack shops are part of each project. Each facility is designed with full service dining in a fine restaurant setting, as well as private dining rooms where smaller parties can be catered.

The Charlotte, Roswell, and Durham locations, each 80,000 s.f., include both assisted living and special care Alzheimer's units. The 110,000 s.f. Atlanta facility includes separate units designed for independent living.
